





MEASURING WHAT MATTERS

This training is designed for organisations who want to better understand their impact. You will learn how to measure impact which will help you to **work in more impactful ways** and **communicate your impact** to funders and communities. You might be a project manager, programme director, or a board member interested in learning how your organisation could better **measure the stuff that matters**.

Over the two-day workshop you will cover:

- A step-by-step introduction to the Social Return on Investment (SROI) process
- The principles underpinning SROI
- Real life applications and examples to show how your organisation can use SROI to increase your impact
- Learn how to complete an impact map
- Learn how to value impact from the perspective of those affected
- Understand causal effects at play in your work

Upon completion of the training you will receive a certification of achievement which is internationally recognised. You can also continue your journey by sitting the exam to become an Associate Practitioner, which gives you a formal and internationally recognised qualification in the field.
